Each package uses the Nankai Train Airport Express service. Approximate time is 37 minutes one way. A couple of expresses trains are available every hour.

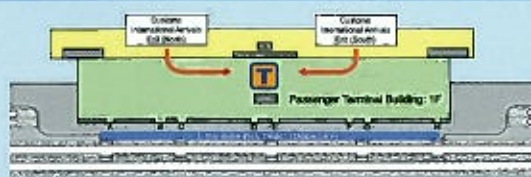


Each good-value package includes the return train tickets between Kansai Airport and Sakai Station, plus an admission ticket for sightseeing facility.
