Information about Access to Kansai International Airport (as of September 21)

Due to the damage from Typhoon Jebi, private cars are currently not allowed to cross the access bridge. Therefore, you are kindly requested to use public transport. Listed below is how to get to the airport.

1) Getting directly to Kansai International Airport without transfers

A. Railway

West Japan Railway Company (JR West) and Nankai Electric Railway Corporation resumed the railway services connecting Rinku Town Station to Kansai International Airport (KIX) on Tuesday, September 18. Consequently, shuttle bus operations between Rinku Town Station and KIX currently running with an irregular schedule were terminated on Monday, September 17 (national holiday).

- · Taxis and other vehicles used by people who find it very difficult to use public transport, such as train and bus
- · Vehicles for airport operations (vehicles with an identification issued by Kansai Airports)
